Networking – the need









- Exchange useful opinions between the projects:
 - Data protection issues
 - Dissemination information
 - Project results
- Discussions on common interesting points raised by the projects:
 - Internal resistances and challenges that they face during the design and implementation of Gender Equality Plans.
 - The consequences of the gender equality interventions and more specifically the unintended consequences that usually are unnoticed
 - The evaluation methodology and the indicators that projects use in order to measure the results of the Gender Equality Plans and its interventions to research institutions
 - User engagement related issues to understand the different stakeholders and the project audience.
 - Terms of sustainability

Networking – tools









- Slack: Discuss on a particular topic under a channel, upload material
- Synapse: members of the e-community may exchange information
- GenPORT: members of the online community may also exchange information and organize e- discussions
- Social media: Retweet and share news and posts, we use a common hashtag (#PGERI). (Proposition: Closed groups, with useful and relative links, information and calls for actions from (Other) Projects.)
- A common mailing list
- Events: Physical meeting Inviting each other, the relevant projects may include a 2 hours' session to exchange ideas. (via the existing budget)

Knowledge exchange – The results



- **Newsletter:** A joint newsletter on a frequent basis to present the development and results of the networking.
- Reporting: The knowledge produced to be published to the wider community
- GenPort: Continuous upload, usage of an existing tool
- Ambassador: Each partner (one per country) involved in relevant projects
 could hold the ambassador position and work as an info point for all kinds of
 stakeholders. A common presentation (one slide per project) could be
 created and be used from now on.
